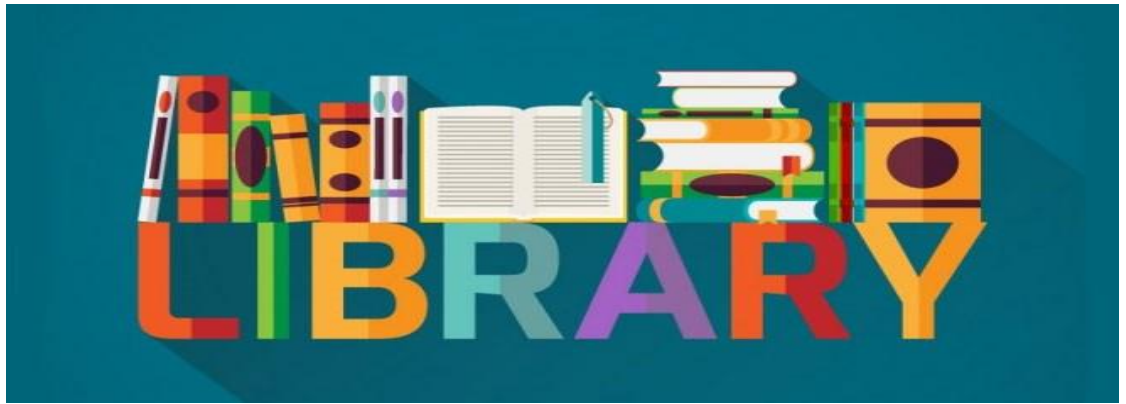

Why should I read for 30 min at home?

- **Reading increases academic achievement:** Students who read regularly at home have better academic outcomes than those who do not. Keep in mind, this also translates into higher salaries in the future.
- **Reading enhances cognitive development:** Reading improves a student’s attention span, concentration and creative thinking.
- **Reading supports long-term health:** Research suggests that having books at home is linked to a longer lifespan and better brain function in adulthood.
- **Reading helps you understand others better:** Reading stories about other people helps readers develop empathy and understand the perspectives of others.
- **Reading to relax:** Research has shown that reading for just 6 minutes can reduce stress by 68% !!

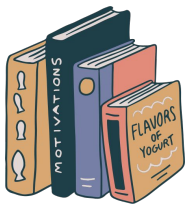

- Stop by the library and ask Ms. Caster to recommend books to you.

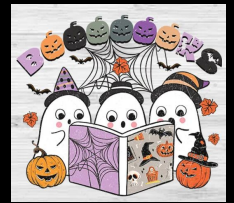

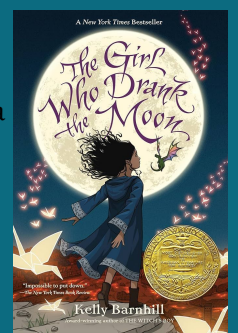
Remember, books check out for 3 weeks. Reminders are sent out weekly via email.
